GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Operates and performs routine maintenance on lift or swing bridges during assigned shift; performs related duties as required.

COMPLEXITY OF DUTIES

Under general supervision, the duties require the use of independent judgment in the safe and efficient operation of bridges.

TYPICAL DUTIES

1. Observes the approach of vessels; directs the stopping of traffic; operates machinery to open and close the bridge.
2. Records all bridge openings, including name of boat, direction of travel and time of opening and closing.
3. Tests equipment and machinery, reports operational failures, and arranges for equipment repair.
4. Obtains pertinent information regarding bridge accidents and prepares reports.
5. Supervises laborers in the routine cleaning, greasing, and oiling of bridge equipment and machinery; assists in sweeping walkways and in snow removal.
6. Performs routine cleaning and maintenance work on equipment.
7. Records daily tide gauge report.
8. Trains subordinate personnel, as required.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

1. Knowledge of the methods used in the safe operation of bridges.
2. Knowledge of the rules and regulations governing navigation on inland waterways.
3. Ability to operate bridge equipment and machinery.
4. Ability to make emergency repairs and adjustments to equipment and machinery.
5. Ability to maintain records and prepare reports.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS - Training and Experience

Graduation from high school and One year of satisfactory experience maintaining or operating electrical or mechanical machinery.

NOTE:

Experience, as outlined above, in excess of the one-year requirement, may be substituted for high school education on a year-for-year basis, up to a maximum of four years.

Must have resided in Nassau County for one year prior to date of applying.
