Students must select either the late U.S. Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg or Vice President Kamala Harris and describe what it means to pursue justice and how either has inspired them to pursue justice. Students must also provide an example of a woman in their daily lives who has inspired them to actively pursue justice.
