[REDACTED] was remanded to Project 350 on a PINS petition issued by Nassau County Family Court. Prior to detention, she resided with her mother in Hempstead. [REDACTED] states she is currently a 9<sup>th</sup> grade student at [REDACTED] High School. She is [REDACTED] tall, weighs [REDACTED] pounds and has brown hair and brown eyes.

**INTERVIEW NARRATIVE**

[REDACTED] is a 14-year old Hispanic female who presents as a quiet and shy youth. She reluctantly provided details of the events leading to her remand and generally answered questions with one-word answers. She reports that she was remanded to Project 350 because she "stayed out overnight" on New Year's Eve. When questioned further, she simply stated "and that's it". She denies problems with school and states that she attends regularly but has had with "a few" unexcused absences. [REDACTED] reports that her mother speaks little English but is trying to help her and enrolled her with the Hispanic Counseling Center in Hempstead. She states that she is eager to return to her mother's care and will "do the right thing" upon her return home.

**NEED TO KNOW**

[REDACTED] is the subject to a PINS Petition filed by Nassau County Family Court. This is her second admission to Project 350.

**PROGRAM GOALS**

To provide a well-child physical examination and necessary medical referrals for treatment.

To provide an academic evaluation and educational program in accordance with grade level and skills

To provide a healthy and nurturing environment to foster satisfactory resident adjustment.

To provide individual and group counseling to improve problem solving and decision making.

To provide telephone contact and personal visits with family members and other authorized persons to facilitate communication and understandings.

**SERVICE PLAN**

The following is a preliminary service plan for [REDACTED] It is based upon information supplied by the resident and the records. The service plan may be modified as necessary.

**MEDICAL:**

[REDACTED] will have a routine medical exam at Hempstead Health Clinic. She denies any medical problems at this time.

**EDUCATION:**

[REDACTED] will be tested and evaluated, and an educational plan will be developed for her. The educational coordinator will contact [REDACTED] High School to advise of her placement at Project 350, and to request academic records and special needs information. [REDACTED] states that she is currently in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade.

[REDACTED] will be encouraged to participate fully with her peers in supervised daily home management tasks and activities. Cooperation, harmony and learning opportunities are built into the resident day, to foster relationship building and enhanced social skills.
