CORPORATION LIMITATIONS:

A corporation may only contribute up to a total of Five thousand dollars (\$5,000) in a calendar year. Corporate contributions to a candidates' committee are further limited to the campaign (election) cycle limit for that candidate.

LLCS, PLLCS:

As of January 31, 2019, LLCs are limited to an aggregate \$5,000 annual contribution (Section 14-120(3)). LLC and PLLC contributions to candidates are limited to the campaign (election) cycle limit for that candidate.

PACS:

There is no limit on contributions to a PAC in any calendar year. Contributions from a PAC to a candidate's committee are limited to the campaign election cycle limits for that candidate.

CAMPAIGN (ELECTION) CYCLE:

The campaign (election) cycle for a particular office begins the day after the last election for that office, and ends on the next Election Day for that office.

PARTY AND CONSTITUTED COMMITTEES:

May receive no more than one hundred and seventeen thousand three hundred dollars (\$117,300) from any individual contributor in a calendar year.

CANDIDATE'S FAMILY LIMITS:

The contribution limit for family members is an aggregated limit from all the candidate's family members (defined as a child, parent, grandparent, brother and sister and the spouse's of those persons.)

PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTIONS:

Countywide, Town, Legislative Districts and District Courts: Individual: Minimum - \$1,000 Maximum - \$50,000 ; Relative: Minimum - \$1,250 Maximum - \$100,000
