Over <u>32%</u> of all VTL Summonses were issued by the **NCPD Highway Patrol Bureau** (**HBP**). A majority of these summonses where issued on the **Long Island Expressway** (**I-495**).

Nassau County Police Department estimates having at least one million public interactions each year. When comparing the number of VTL stops to the number of public interactions, VTL stops account for less than <u>6.1%</u> of all interactions.
