Dear Supervisor Clavin, Deputy County Executive Schneider and Chairman Ryan,

I am writing on behalf of the residents of the apartment complex at 1888 Foster Meadow Lane ("the complex"), Elmont.

Residents complain that the complex continues to flood during heavy rainstorms, like last week. Residents state that the flooding appears to be from a partially ajar storm water drain (photos attached), located behind the complex on the property of the Town of Hempstead's Westover Gardens Apartment Complex. Further, I am advised that the flooding is partially caused by water runoff from the Water Authority of Western Nassau County's property, located behind the complex. Residents report that this flooding has caused problems to the complex and the grounds. Upon information, residents are currently living in a hotel while the damage caused by last week's storm is being fixed.

Residents are concerned that continuous flooding may cause more serious problems to the complex. Residents state that the flooding has continued to get worse, possibly caused by a problem with the pipe or the system. Therefore, residents and I respectfully request a meeting with representatives from the Town of Hempstead, Nassau County and the Water Authority of Western Nassau County to visit the site and verify the cause of the flooding and how this problem can be resolved.
