

2024 Spring Swim Lesson/Water Exercise Session

SWIM LESSON/AQUATIC FITNESS REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

Registration will take place online starting Saturday, March 2nd

All class registration will take place starting 9am

Registration will be online only for the first 24 hours. Both online and “in person” registration will be available starting Sunday, March 3 at 9am. Online registration is strongly encouraged and all registration will end one week after classes start. The Spring session classes will start on Monday, March 4. The class schedule will be available in mid to late February.

Account access:

Visit: <https://secure.rec1.com/NY/nassau-county-ny/catalog> and go to “Login/create account”.

First time login in process:

- Enter your e-mail as your user name. (if your e-mail is not recognized, see the “important” section below)
- Click on “forgot password?” and you will then get an e-mail to set your password and log in

Please do not create a new accountbefore checking to see if you already have an account. You will already have an account if you did business at one of the Nassau County Parks facilities (not just the Aquatic Center) and previously purchased something requiring your name and address, for instance.....a Leisure Pass, swim lesson, facility memberships, summer rec program, ice skating session, cabana lottery, etc.

Important – You can only access your online account if your e-mail was entered into the system at the time of any previous purchase. If your e-mail is not recognized at time of log-in, it probably means your e-mail was not entered previously. If so, please call 572-0501 and we can enter it. Again, **please do not create a new account** unless you are certain you’ve never done business with our Nassau County Parks system before.

Registration process once logged in:

- Children’s names and dates of birth can be added through the “Accounts” page. Do not register classes under the parents name as age restrictions will block you from finishing.
- Swim lesson selections can be found under the “Catalog” button and then on the “Aquatic Center Main Pool” location. You can register and pay at this area of the website.
- If you have a credit in the system, it can be seen on your accounts page. You should not be creating a new account if you have a credit from 2020. You will already have an account.

Evaluations & Proper class selection:

If you are unsure what class your child should enter, please call 572-0521 and ask for Rob or Gail. Messages will not be returned. Please call until you get a live person on the phone. Free in person evaluations will take place on the following dates every 15 minutes (registration must be done in advance and online starting 2/5 at 9am):
Monday, 2/26: 4 pm-8 pm; Wednesday, 2/28: 4 pm-8 pm; Thursday, 2/29: 4 pm-8 pm

Age Restrictions:

Infant/Toddler classes: ages 6 mos. – 36 months (each child must be accompanied in the water by an adult)

Pre School Levels 1-3: ages 3 – 5 years

Levels 1-6: ages 6 and over

Teen/Adult: ages 13 and over (also “Get Comfortable in water” class)

Jr. Lifeguard: ages 11-15

Water Exercise: ages 18 and over

Refunds:

We will not refund, credit or transfer any incorrect class selections. No exceptions will be made. If you place your child in the wrong class, your child cannot take the class and no credits, refunds or class transfers will be granted. Registering for more than one class is not permitted. No refunds for multiple registrations.
