

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Fees: Nassau County residents ages 13 & older are required to have an individual Nassau County Leisure Passport in order to receive resident discount rates. Children 12 & under must be accompanied by an adult (18 & over) with a Leisure Passport in order to receive resident discount rates. Patrons without a Leisure Passport are admitted upon payment of non-resident admission fees. No refunds or rain checks.
2. All patrons (swimmers & non-swimmers) who wish to enter the pool deck or use the locker room facilities are required to pay the proper admission fees. Non-admission viewing area and bathrooms are available on our upper level.
3. Children 12 years of age & under will not be admitted except when accompanied by an adult (18 & older) who must stay in the building and assume full responsibility for the child's safety and conduct.
4. Bathing suits are required – no shorts or cutoffs. Shorts style bathing suits require an inner lining.
5. Lifejackets and/or floatation assist devices of any kind are strictly prohibited.
6. You cannot reserve any lanes or pool space without a permit issued by the facility for that purpose. Performing private swim instruction without a permit is strictly prohibited. Lap swimming is available on first-come, first-serve basis and you will have to share a lane if the demand warrants.
7. No food or beverages are permitted on the pool deck, gym, locker rooms, outside patio or grandstand area. Food is permitted in the lower level lobby area only. **NO GLASS BOTTLES ALLOWED AT ALL!**
8. Lockers are for daily use only. Any locks left overnight can be removed (items will go in lost and found).
9. Diving is permitted in the diving pool only (when available).
10. Dressing and/or undressing must take place in the locker rooms. Children 5 years of age & older are not permitted in the locker room of opposite sex (they may use the family dressing room).
11. Use of the jacuzzi and sauna is limited to current Total Health Pass and Swimming Access Pass members. The daily admission fee to use the pool does not include use of the jacuzzi and sauna.
12. Use of the upper level gym is limited to current Total Health Pass members only. The daily admission fee to use the pool does not include use of the workout and fitness rooms.
13. Swimming is prohibited when the pool is closed or in sections with no lifeguard on duty.
14. Strollers with wheels are not permitted on the pool deck (non-wheeled infant carriers are permitted).
15. No person is permitted to enter the pool area with open wounds, sores or inflamed eyes, mouth, nose or ear discharges. Pollution of the swimming pools by urinating, discharge of fecal matter, expectorating or blowing the nose is prohibited.
16. The following are strictly prohibited in the pool area: ball playing of any type, pushing, running, dunking or boisterous conduct, toys, play equipment, baby carriages, playpens, floating devices, swim fins, masks, glasses, snorkels, food, beverages, alcohol, smoking, or glass containers.
17. Admission may be restricted or denied at the discretion of the Pool Manager whenever it is deemed necessary.
18. The Commissioner of Parks, Recreation & Museums or designee shall implement any additional rules and regulations necessary for the safety and welfare of patrons. The Pool Manager is authorized to order the expulsion of any individual violating the above rules and regulations or interfering with the safety and well-being of patrons.
