Engaging The Communities Of District 1

With holiday festivities across the district and an array of new community leaders to engage with after redistricting, the last few months have been jam-packed for Legislator Davis and his colleagues.

In **North Baldwin**, Legislator Davis joined the Baldwin Oaks Civic Association for their annual holiday party and final meeting of 2025.

In **Roosevelt**, he joined the community in celebrating Ann Hickson's retirement after 10 years of service on the Roosevelt Public Library Board of Trustees.

Additionally, Legislator Davis rang in the holiday season with events at the **Rockville Centre** Martin Luther King, Jr. Community Center - where he serves as the organization's Vice President - joined the Rockville Centre and **South Hempstead** communities at Christmas tree and Menorah lightings, and partnered with the **Hempstead NAACP**, which sponsors local families for the holiday season.

Legislator Davis furthermore had the opportunity to partner with **CSEA Local 830** and the **One Through One Resource Center** in **Hempstead** to deliver toys and holiday tidings to deserving local youngsters served by that community center.

During the holiday season, Legislator Davis joined the Rockville Centre girls' volleyball and soccer teams in celebrating their respective State and County victories at the unveiling of a new championship sign on Sunrise Highway and Long Beach Road.



Legislator Davis Sworn In For New Legislative Term

On Jan. 8, Legislator Davis and his colleagues took the oath of office for a new Legislative term. It is the second term for Legislator Davis, who was first elected in 2023.

Since taking office, he has quickly earned recognition for his attention to detail, intense focus upon equitable community service, and incisive, persistent questioning as he upholds the Legislature's crucial role of providing oversight of the County administration.



In this new term, Legislator Davis will represent the communities of Rockville Centre, Roosevelt, South Hempstead, Hempstead Village and North Baldwin. He will serve as Ranking Member of the Public Safety and Planning, Development and the Environment committees, and be a member of the Rules and Veterans & Senior Affairs committees.

Continuing to Invest In District 1's Future

Legislator Davis is committed to advancing major infrastructure investments that will stimulate economic growth, promote public safety and enhance quality of life across the communities of District 1 through the Fiscal Year 2026 capital plan. Some of the key projects throughout the district include:

- **\$20,000,000 - Babylon Turnpike, Roosevelt** - Streetscape and Traffic Safety (design phase underway)
- **\$12,386,000 - Nassau Road, Roosevelt** - Streetscape and Traffic Safety (design phase underway)
- **Rev. Arthur Mackey Park, Roosevelt** - Tennis Court Resurfacing and Future Improvements
- **Lakeview Avenue, Rockville Centre** - Streetscape and Traffic Safety (forthcoming traffic study)
- **\$500,000 - Forthcoming Improvements for Tanglewood Preserve, Rockville Centre**

Additionally, the following streetscapes and traffic safety projects are planned throughout the entirety of **Hempstead Village** across District 1 and its two neighboring Legislative districts -

- **\$16,212,000 - Peninsula Boulevard** – Design Phase Underway
- **\$11,000,000 - Franklin Avenue** – Design Phase Underway
- **\$6,500,000 - Clinton Avenue** - Design Phase Complete
- **\$6,800,000 - Washington Avenue** - Design Phase Underway
- **Greenwich Street** – Traffic Study Underway
