The registration of the RV must match the Leisure Pass holder. If it does not and/or is registered to a Non-Resident you will be charged the NON-Leisure Pass Rate. Falsifying of residency and/or Leisure Pass ownership will be subject to price increase or removal.

Campground Rules:

- **Alcoholic Beverages:** Alcoholic beverages are permitted in moderation. No open containers may be carried about the campground. Intemperate use of alcoholic beverages or disorderly conduct associated with consumption of such beverages shall be cause for eviction from campground.
- **Animals:** Licenses and proof of vaccination must be provided for all pets. Household animals are welcome, provided that their owners walk such pets within the designated area on a leash and pick up afterwards. Leash can be no longer than 6 feet. Pets must not be left unattended or tied up for long periods of time; Pets are not to be left alone at campsites. If a pet barks constantly, bites, or becomes a nuisance to others, owners will be required to remove it from the campground. Pets are only permitted on campsites.
- **Appropriate Recreational Vehicle:** An appropriate type of shelter is required. Example: Van Camper, Pop-up Trailer, Trailer, or Motor Home. Commercial Vehicles and boat trailers are not permitted on campsites.
- **Campfires:** Campfires are not permitted on campsites unless you have an approved campfire container. Ask personnel on duty for approved campfire container types.
- **Fireworks:** NO FIREWORKS OF ANY KIND ARE PERMITTED!
SPARKLERS INCLUDED!
- **Campsite Parking:** Is limited to **ONE** Recreational Vehicle and **ONE** additional Passenger Vehicle. **ALL RECREATIONAL & PASSENGER VEHICLES MUST BE BACKED INTO CAMPSITE.** Tents are not permitted on Recreational Vehicle Campsites (water & electric campsite).
- **CHECK IN TIME IS 3PM. CHECK OUT TIME IS 11AM:** All campers must depart when the reservation is up or a late fee will be assessed!
- **Fly Tents:** Fly Tents without a bottom are permitted next to the Recreational Vehicle.

- **Guests and Children:** All guests must sign in at the main office. Number of guests per registered camper may be limited to the discretion of camp director. Guests must park in area designated for guest parking (Battle Row only-permit required). A permit is required for guests' vehicles staying overnight. Guests may only visit between 9 AM - 11 PM. Registered campers are responsible for their guests and children. It is your responsibility to inform them of the rules. Children under 21 are not allowed to stay in the campground overnight without adult supervision.
- **Kite Flying:** Due to close proximity of high-tension wires and heavy volume of traffic, kite flying; model planes; rocket launching, and similar airborne activities are prohibited as a matter of public safety.
- **Laundry:** Restroom facilities are NOT to be used for laundry purposes. Hanging up laundry is prohibited in campground.
- **Picnic Tables:** Picnic tables must remain at designated campsite locations.
- **Propane Tanks:** Propane tanks must be mounted to Recreational Vehicle and should not exceed 85 pounds.
- **Quiet Time:** The hours from 11 PM to 8 AM are designated Quiet Time. Please observe the no generator operation during these times.
- **Refuse:** Garbage and refuse must be placed in plastic bags and disposed of in trashcans. Campsite housekeeping is the responsibility of each camper. A service fee will be added to your account for campsites that need extensive cleanup or restoration/
- **Repairs:** Only in extreme emergencies will repairs be to any vehicle be allowed.
- **Swimming Pools:** Swimming pools are not permitted at Battle Row Campground as a matter of public safety.
- **Tent Camping:** Only one (1) tent per site - four individuals or a single family per campsite. One passenger vehicle per campsite.
- **Traffic Control:** Motor vehicle operators must obey all posted speed limit signs and route directions. Battle Row Campground requires you SHOW CAR PASS AT STOP SIGN. Registered mini-bikes, motor bikes, scooters, and motorcycles are not permitted on campground roads, except for entry and egress to assigned campsite. Non-licensed operators may not operate a motor vehicle of any type within campground. Bicycle riding is permitted ONLY within campground - sunrise to sunset (Nickerson Beach). Bike riding is permitted within moderation - sunrise to sunset on marked trails. Roller blades, scooters, and skateboards are not permitted within park grounds. Please respect other campers' sites. use the

surrounding roadways as your walkway. **RESIDENT CAMPERS & STAFF ARE NOT PERMITTED TO MOVE ANY VEHICLES.**

- **Waste Materials:** The Gray & Black water must be dumped ONLY at designated dumping stations. Gray water must be in a closed container, and a sewer hose must be used to dump. Registered campers may utilize the dump stations without charge. Non-registered campers may use the dump station after paying the required fee. Washing of cars, recreational vehicles, etc. is not permitted.
- **NO Commercial Vehicles:** Commercial vehicles are not permitted in the campgrounds.
- **Refunds:** There are ***NO REFUNDS!***

Permittee will obey all Laws, Rules and Regulations, including but not limited to, all Parks Department Rules and Regulations.

NASSAU COUNTY ASSUMES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR CAMPER'S LOST OR STOLEN ARTICLES, DAMAGE TO CAMPING EQUIPMENT, OR FOR ANY ACCIDENTS THAT OCCUR WITHIN BATTLE ROW CAMPGROUNDS.

I HAVE READ AND WILL AGREE TO ABIDE BY AND FOLLOW ALL RULES PUT FORTH BY THE BATTLE ROW CAMPGROUND. IN THE EVENT OF VIOLATION OF ANY OF THESE RULES NASSAU COUNTY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO EXPEL VIOLATORS AT THEIR OWN EXPENSE, RESULTING IN FORFEITURE OF ALL FEES PAID.
