



Potential Debris Management Sites (DMS):
Draft Screening Results

To identify potential Debris Management Sites (DMS), public park properties over 5 acres in size were evaluated for proximity to floodplains. Properties with substantial portions within the 1% annual chance floodplain, or with access restrictions due to flooding of adjacent areas, were eliminated. In limited cases, the boundaries of DMS locations were altered to avoid floodplain areas (see Usage/Notes field). Properties with substantial portions in wetlands, groundwater protection areas, or listed on the National Register of Historic Places were eliminated. Nature preserves were eliminated due to high environmental value. Other environmental considerations and site information are noted in Appendix J: Table J-1.
